GATHER

LISTEN

Reader: A reading from the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah

I said, "I do not know how to speak. I am too young!" But the LORD answered me, Do not say, "I am too young." To whomever I send you, you shall go; whatever I command you, you shall speak.
